Review of Speak Up Week activities

This is a summary of the types of activities that took place across the NHS in Scotland during Speak Up Week 2022:

Staff communications and digital engagement

- Speak Up Week highlighted in newsletters, core staff briefings, daily shout outs on staff apps
- Special Speak Up Week features in news articles, blog posts, podcasts and social media
- Updates from managers at staff meetings or huddles
- Videos on a variety of themes including general information on speaking up and reflections on Speak Up Week
- Launch of targeted campaigns or toolkits to support speaking up or raising concerns (including but not limited to whistleblowing)
- Use of Speak Up Week email footers
- Promotion of INWO Turas training and events
- Testimonies from Confidential Contacts on their role and why they do it
- Sharing Whistleblowing Annual Reports
- Use of Speak Up Week branded products such as pop up banners, leaflets and posters.
- Stationery promoting speaking up pens, post its, notepads

Senior leadership engagement

- Staff message from senior leadership
- Videos from Chief Executives, Directors and/or Whistleblowing Champions, including conversations between Chief Executives and staff representatives
- Chief Executive taking part in a Facebook live broadcast
- Directors attending drop in sessions and/or walkarounds

Events and outreach

- Q&A events, 'Meet your Confidential Contact' sessions and staff town hall meetings
- Drop in sessions whistleblowing leads, senior managers, Whistleblowing Champions
- Coffee mornings (including coffee vouchers)
- Information stands, staff presentations and surveys.
- Promotion events for doctors in training
- Walkarounds Directors, Whistleblowing Champions, Confidential Contacts
- Word search competition with prizes
- Speak Up pledges
